

OFFICIAL RULES

-Check in starts at 2:00pm on Friday, April 29th. As the cooks arrive they will be randomly selected for their spots in the parking lot by drawing numbers from a hat.

-BBQ must be prepared on site. Chili can be made off site and brought in and inspected prior to event.

-Event starts at 11 am and goes until all food is gone or 2 pm whichever comes first.

-BBQ entries must be a minimum of 20#, chili entries a minimum of 6 gallons. All ingredients and supplies must be provided by the team, except for the tasting kits which will be supplied by Kiwanis.

-You may not sell anything from your booth. You can give free handouts (cards, water etc)

-Cooks are to prepare and cooked in a sanitary manner. Meats must be kept at or below 40 degrees prior to cooking and all cooked meat must be kept at 140 degrees or higher. Your cooking rigs are your responsibility. Running water and electricity (110) will be provided: However you will need to provide extension cords and water hoses.

- A new category has been added this year. Judges will be selected and given random kits with score cards.

-The crowd is the judge. With each tasting kit, participants will be issued ballots to cast their votes for top winners in each category. Violators of the rules will be disqualified from winning.

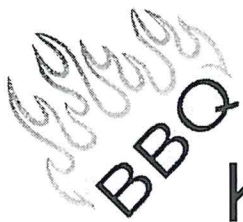
-Results and awards to be announced from main Red Fern Stage at 3:00pm on Saturday the 30th.

-Cook as much food as possible! The more people that sample your food the better chance you have to win.

-Entries may stay overnight with their smokers and grills; however alcohol is not allowed at any point during this event.
